I am ready for this. I will sleep in a new house, on a brand new bed and mattress. I never had that much newness. 😊





A NEW BEGINNING FOR OUR NEWEST 'ADRIANA'

Adriana S., age 19, has just come to us in September. She has a difficult background and has given permission to share parts of her story. She is one of 7 siblings – only 2 have the same father and mother. She does not remember a time in her life when her mother was not an alcoholic, and because of that she was never employed. Her biological father passed away before she knew him, and at this time she does not like to speak of a stepfather. Her 'house' had electricity, but food was always a struggle; she experienced a lot of neglect and lack of interest from her family and she is not close to any of them. As a youth she became a Christian at a village Bible club. Adriana says she can see the Lord's care and provision for her and that since she opened her heart for Jesus she got the confidence that He won't ever leave her. She was sponsored to a Christian High School where she was the only one in her family to finish high school. Through a connection at the Christian High school she was recommended to our program. She has felt so well and safe since coming to the Home of Hope and we are excited to see how the Lord will continue to care for her!
